

Argan, Inc.'s Wholly Owned Subsidiary Gemma Power Systems Enters into an EPC Agreement with Moxie Liberty LLC for a Gas Fired Power Plant

April 26, 2013 - ROCKVILLE, Md.--Argan, Inc. (NYSE MKT: AGX) announced that its wholly owned subsidiary, Gemma Power Systems (GPS) entered into an EPC Agreement with Moxie Liberty LLC (Moxie Liberty) in connection with the construction and design of a 825 MW gas fired power plant in Pennsylvania.

Gemma Power, Inc. (GPI) has been funding Moxie Liberty in the development of this power plant project and has advanced approximately \$4.1 million in working capital to the project. On March 28, 2013, Moxie Liberty entered into a Membership Interests Purchase Agreement with a third party investor who will provide advances of certain preconstruction costs. The consummation of the purchase of Moxie Liberty as well as the ability of GPS to fully proceed under the EPC Agreement are contingent upon the third party investor securing permanent financing for the project.

Argan's primary business is designing and building energy plants through its Gemma Power Systems subsidiary. These energy plants include traditional gas as well as alternative energy including biodiesel, ethanol, and renewable energy sources such as wind power. Argan also owns Southern Maryland Cable, Inc.
